E.A. Vaughn Wildlife Management Area	Rehabilitation	Marsh Ditch Plugging & Restoration of marsh hydrology by plugging of grid ditches constructed in the 1930's and 1940's. The purpose is to restrict daily tidal intrusions, high marsh inundation to spring and storm tides, and maintain water in pools and pannes, 35 ditch plugs were installed during Fall 2007 and Winter 2008. The ditch plugs were installed at elevations roughly equal to the surrounding marsh surface. In general, ditch plugs were constructed of 6 foot long by 9 foot wide, 5/8 inch thick C-lock Geo Guard-30 vinyl sheet piling, which was driven into the marsh using an amphibious excavator and covered with ditch sediment directly upstream of the plug.
