Condito Property - Hingham	Protection/Maintenance	The Condito property is a 5.66-acre parcel across from the Foster School. The property, a wildlife habitat with many song and meadow birds, probably could not be developed.	Forested Wetland	5.66	0
James Brook Parcel - Cohasset	Protection/Maintenance	Purchase of 9.6 acres of open space known as the James property and for a 30-acre expanse off of Route 3A. Purchases would help with watershed protection. \$400,000 of the total will be bonded over 15 years.	Riparian	39.60	0
Keene Street Parcel - Duxbury	Protection/Maintenance	Through Community Preservation Act funding, the Town of Duxbury purchased one acre of open space that was deemed unbuildable. The property is located next to the recently renovated Keene Street Athletic Fields.	Freshwater Marsh	1.00	0
Mill Creek	Rehabilitation	Phragmites removal and reconstruction of storm drain system from an adjacent parking lot including BMPs. Debris was removed and fencing installed along the parking lot to discourage dumping. Pre-construction monitoring to assess wetland conditions.	Tidal Wetland	1.00	0
North River Parcel - Marshfield	Protection/Maintenance	Open space purchase of a parcel along the North River that includes frontage on the North River, pine woods, a gazebo and a picnic area. Purchase will provide for habitat protection and passive recreation. Parcel purchased with EOEA Self-help grant of \$420,000. Entire purchase price was \$780,000.	Freshwater Marsh	25.00	0
Peregrine White Drive - Marshfield	Protection/Maintenance	The Town of Marshfield used Community Preservation Act funds to purchase 50.55 acres of open space (upland salt marsh) located off Peregrine White Drive.	Tidal Wetland	50.55	0
Ship Pond Road - Plymouth	Protection/Maintenance	This project protects one of Plymouth's oldest preserves, conserves outstanding wildlife habitat, and brings a greenway closer to reality. Protection of all of this land greatly increases walking trail location options for an eventual Myles-Standish-State-Forest-to-the-Sea Greenway, and is a key action in protecting the rural atmosphere and quality of life in this section of Plymouth. South Swamp - Scituate	Protection/Maintenance	For acquisition of open space in close proximity to the South Swamp that contains protected wetlands. Project as voted went out to bid and a contract was awarded. Delineation of the Scituate wetlands is complete and delineation of South Swamp wetlands in Norwell is in progress.	Forested Wetland	8.50	0
State Game Farm Tidal Restoration	Rehabilitation	Culvert replacement to increase tidal flow to freshwater stream. Coordinated by our partner the Massachusetts Wetlands Restoration Program. Volunteers monitored the marsh system above and below the culvert both before and after the restoration to document project success.	Tidal Wetland	8.00	0
