Hungarian Club, Clark, NJ-Acquisition	Union County Department of Parks	The 0.66-acre property was acquired by the Union County Department of Parks with funds from the Union County Open Space and Recreation Trust Fund and NJ Dept of Environmental Protection Green Acres program. The property, known as Hungarian Club, is located in Clark Township and is adjacent to the Clark reservoir. While future plans for the property are still under consideration, it could be used for light recreation and educational activities. This site, together with previously acquired property including and surrounding the Reservoir, creates a continuous greenway that acts as a natural, low cost storm drainage system.
