Ludwigia Eradication in the Peconic River	Peconic Estuary Program	Ludwigia peploides, a non-native aquatic invasive species, was detected in the Peconic River a number of years ago. Since 2006, the PEP has been working with a number of partners and coordinating volunteers to assist in the removal of this species from the Peconic Riverine system. Over the course of four years, 13 Hand-Pull events were held in which 438 volunteers donated 2,360 hours of their time to remove 130 cubic yards of Ludwigia from the river. The population is now largely under control and an outreach effort has been launched encouraging recreational users of this waterbody to pull out any remaining Ludwigia if they see it during the course of their outing on the river. Monitoring and maintenance pulling will continue, but we do not anticipate the need for any additional large-scale "pull" events.	In-Stream	169	5	0
