All of these properties are in areas identified in the Land Conservation Plan for New Hampshire's Coastal Watersheds. The project was primarily funded by a \$1.3 million federal Coastal and Estuarine Land Conservation Program (CELCP) grant. The five properties that are part of the Isinglass River Corridor Conservation Project include the Bedford property (acquisition), Cooper-Walworth easement, Courmoyer easement, Isinglass River property (acquisition), and the Strafford SAU easement.
